More than 85% of women having a vaginal birth suffer some degree of perineal trauma (a tear or episiotomy).1,2



It is estimated that at least 70% of women in the UK and US require perineal suturing following a vaginal birth.1,2



Currently, fingers are the most common practice when retracting a wound during perineal suturing. This requires a second clinician if you wish to suture with both hands free.
